Here's how it works:

To participate and receive prizes, submit your reading & activity log to the Lopez Public Library by August 21st. There is no cost and no registration required to participate. Any reader who logs at least 12 books and/or activities (at least 5 must be books) will receive a completion prize.

What counts as a book? Any book at your reading level: e-book, audio-book, paper book; any genre including graphic novels – In other words, if it is a book, it counts! Being read-to by a friend or grown-up also counts.

What counts as an activity?

We encourage you to do fun activities with your family. Viewing or attending a virtual library program, or using library activity packets also count as activities you can log. See list on the back for more ideas. Write down each activity on a separate line.
