## **What, Where, When**

Since Lopez Fresh, at the Family Resource Center, can no longer accept home grown produce, (a temporary situation), the Grow-A-Row team is accepting and distributing the extra produce that home gardeners are donating.

**Beginning Tuesday, May 26 and every Tuesday throughout the summer**, the Locavores will be at Woodmen Hall from 9 to 10:30am accepting cleaned and ready-for-packaging fresh produce from home gardeners.

**From 10:30 to noon, at Woodmen Hall, the cleaned and packaged produce will be available to the community on a first-come-first-served basis.** Priority will be given to Seniors and Meals On Wheels. This produce will be packaged separately and will accompany their food delivery.
