

<b>Position Title:</b>	<b>BiblioBlooms (Landscaping)</b>
<b>Purpose:</b>	The BiblioBlooms will help make the grounds around the library as inviting and welcoming as the library building itself. The grounds are the community's "outside library" which individuals and groups can choose to use in a variety of ways. Having a beautiful, well-maintained and thoughtful landscape provides a space for people to tune in to nature while they use library services.
<b>Position Summary:</b>	BiblioBlooms will have the opportunity to maintain and improve the overall landscape of the library. Volunteers will be charged with weeding, selective pruning, spreading mulch, and other activities to improve the health and beauty of the grounds.
<b>Benefits:</b>	Lots of time in fresh air and surrounded by nature. BiblioBlooms will also get great exercise, at whatever level is appropriate to them, through activities such as weeding, pruning, spreading compost, and more.

<b>Skill Sets:</b>	Gardening experience is appreciated but not necessary. A willingness to learn about the plantings around the library and what it takes to nurture and maintain them is important.
<b>Commitment:</b>	This is very much seasonal work with the bulk happening in the Spring when there will be monthly garden parties of 2-3 hours each focused on weeding, pruning/shaping existing trees and plants, and putting down mulch. One or two garden parties to be held in the Autumn to put the garden to bed for the winter.
